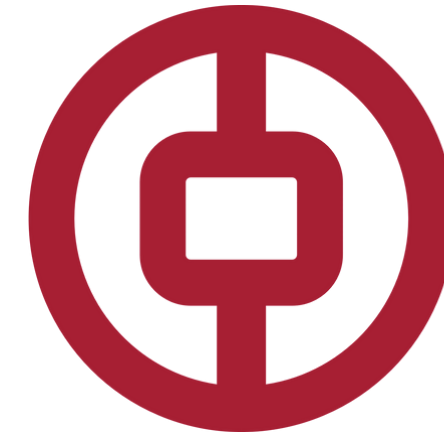

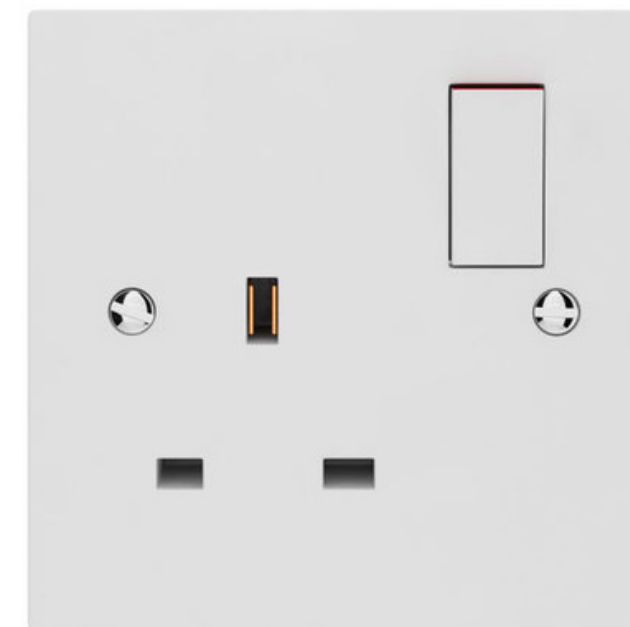
Important Documents

- PASSPORT with valid VISA
- HKUST admission letter
- Email/letter confirming hall place
- Proof of residential address in home country Identity documents (KTP, SIM, etc.)
- Copy of Family Card
- Proof of tuition fee payment
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Passport-sized photographs
- HK-standard (4cm x 5cm)
- Original copies of academic records (certificates, transcript, etc.)
- No-Objection Letter (for working and internship purposes)

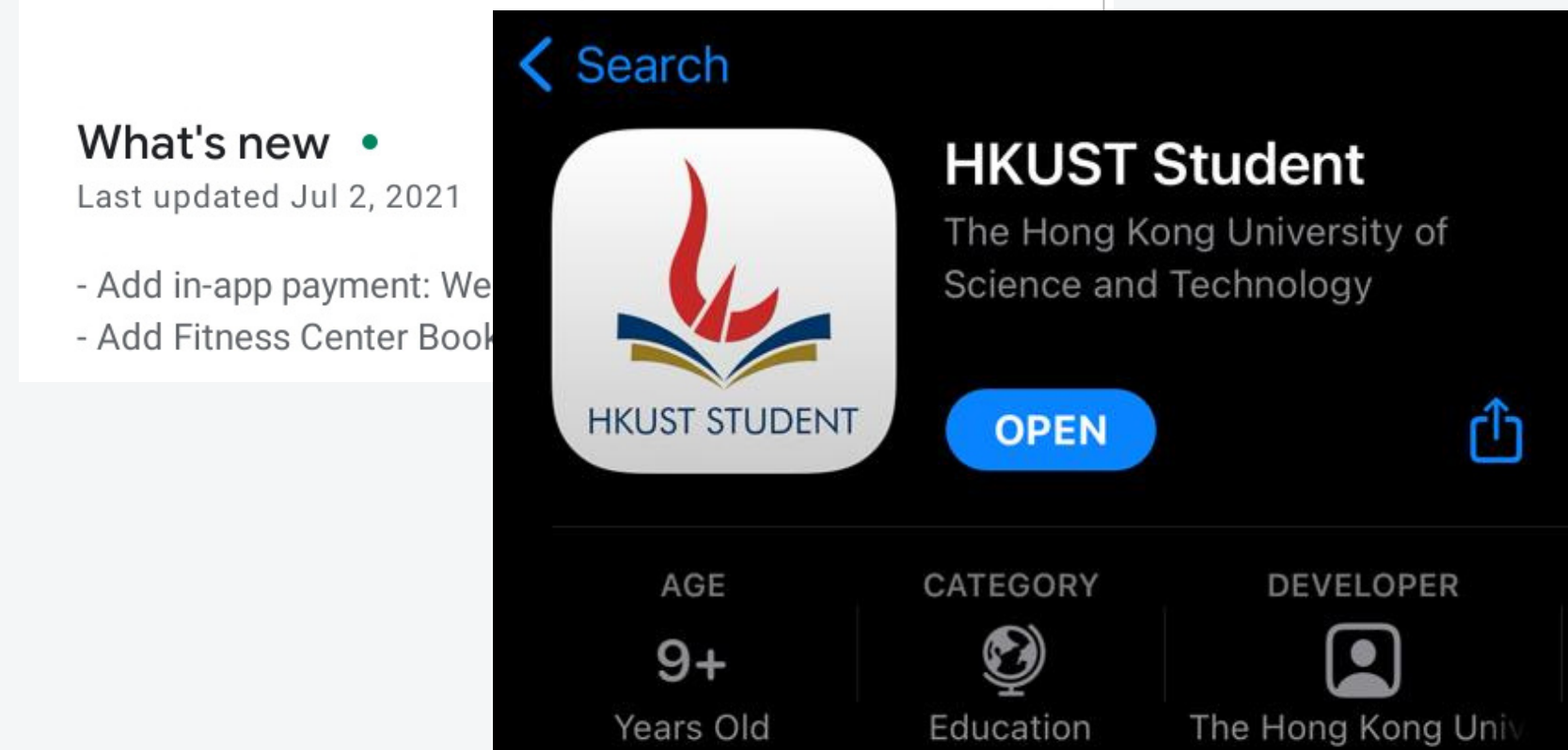
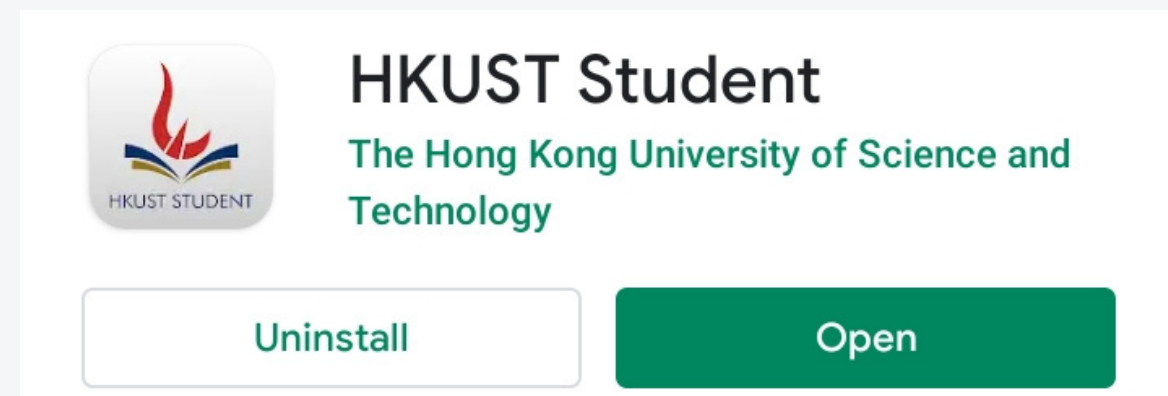
Student ID is essential for your everyday life, including for laundry, air-conditioner bill, and most importantly University facility access

- Collect your Personalized Octopus Card, following the dates & instructions in the receipt

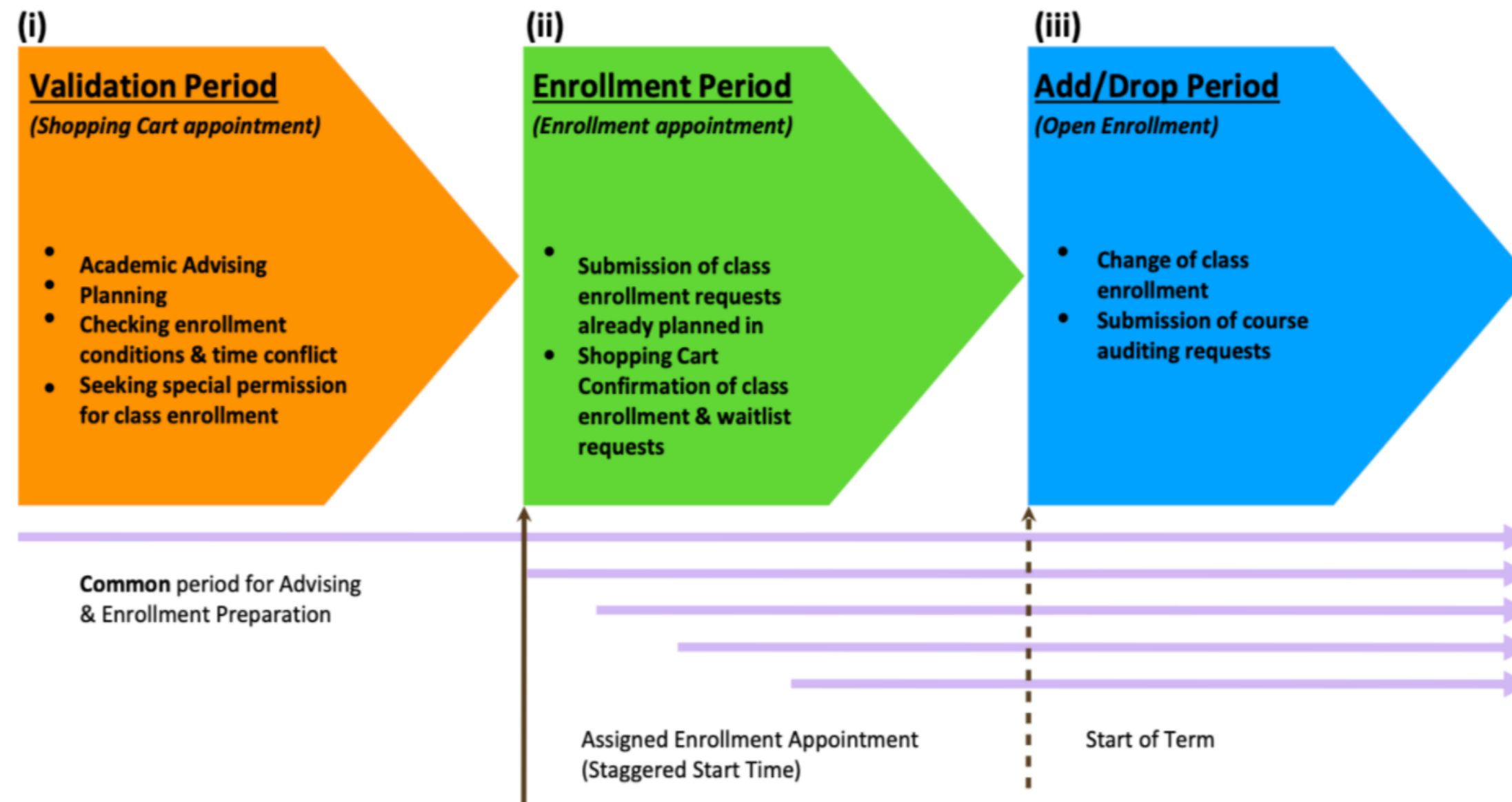
Course Enrollment

Academic Study

- Generally, you need **120** credits to graduate
- 36 credits are to fulfill common core requirements
- More information: http://uce.ust.hk/wec/courses/course_curriculum.html
- The normal workload is **15–18 credits** per **semester** (differ by school)
- You can get **a credit transfer on entry** (max. 30 credits) (refer to the official information from the university)
- Courses can either use absolute grading or a curved grading system (majority is curved)
- Professors will use Canvas to post lecture notes, homework, quizzes, etc.

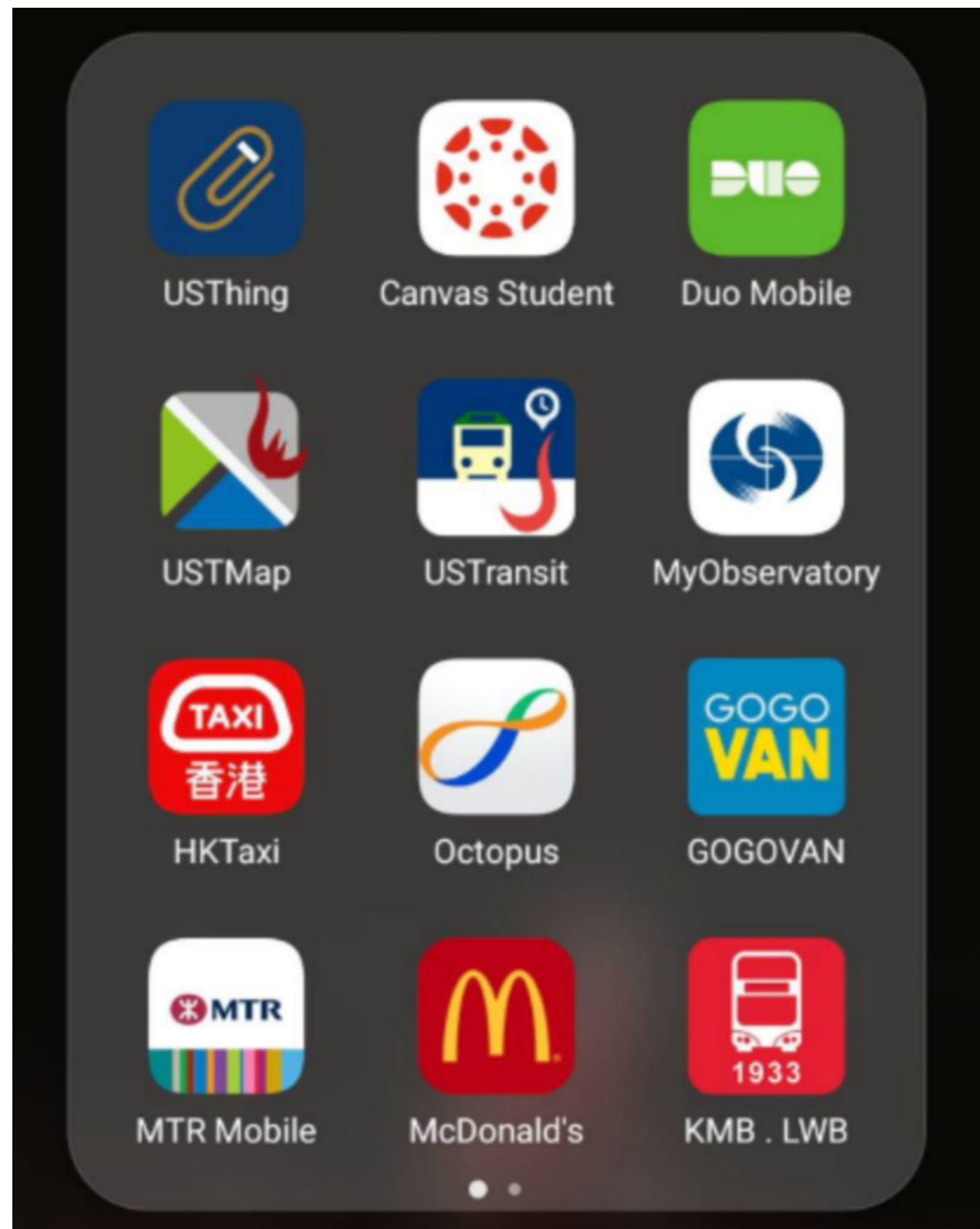

Academic Study

- Check your pre-enrolled courses at HKUST Student Center
- Check your academic requirements
- Check Class Schedule and Quotas: <https://w5.ab.ust.hk/wcq/cgi-bin/1740/> (make sure you're choosing the right term!)
- Plan your schedule and check course/professor reviews at UST space (optional)
- Select the courses you want to take at HKUST Student Center and add them to the shopping cart
- Enroll these courses during your designated enrollment time (check your enrollment date and time at Student Center)
- Add/Swap/Drop classes before the end of the Add/Drop period

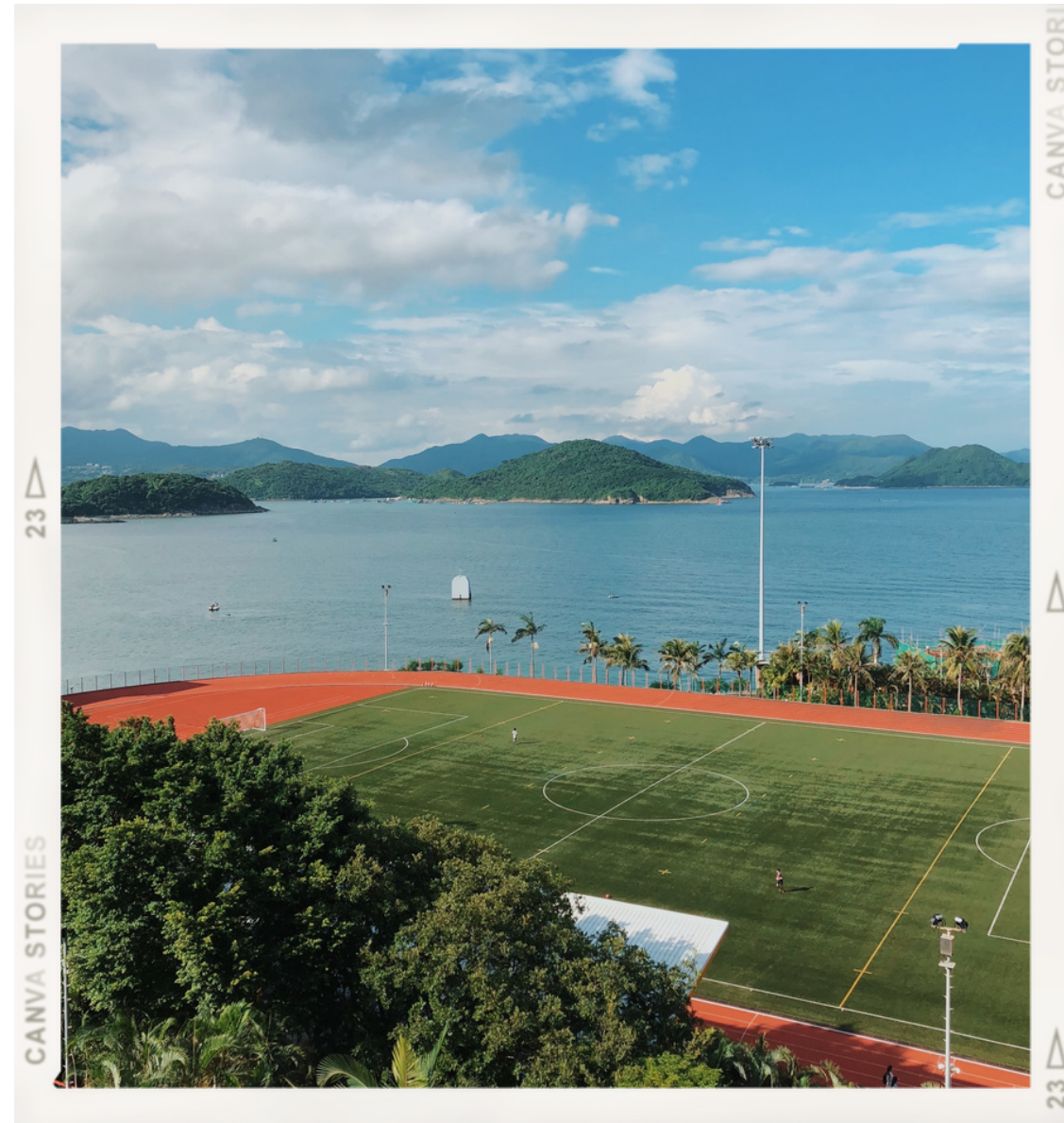

Current Arrangement

Summary

- In **Fall 2021**, the targeted default mode of delivery for classes will be **in-person on campus**.
- All members of the University should therefore **plan to be in Hong Kong** well in time for the **Fall term**, as far as possible.
- Some courses/sections would be offered in [mixed-mode](#), [blended](#), or **real-time online mode**. This will be decided on pedagogical grounds, with inputs from instructors and Department/Division Heads, following the relevant approval process.
- After the add-drop period, if a class has **any student(s) who cannot be physically present** in Hong Kong, that class will be held in **mixed-mode** or [mixed-mode lite](#).
- In order to return to the ideals of our community and resume normal teaching and learning and other campus activities this **Fall**, we encourage **all students**, faculty, staff, and contractors working on campus to get **vaccinated** by the Fall Term. If anyone cannot be vaccinated for medical reasons, regular COVID-19 testing with results submitted to the University for confirmation will be required.

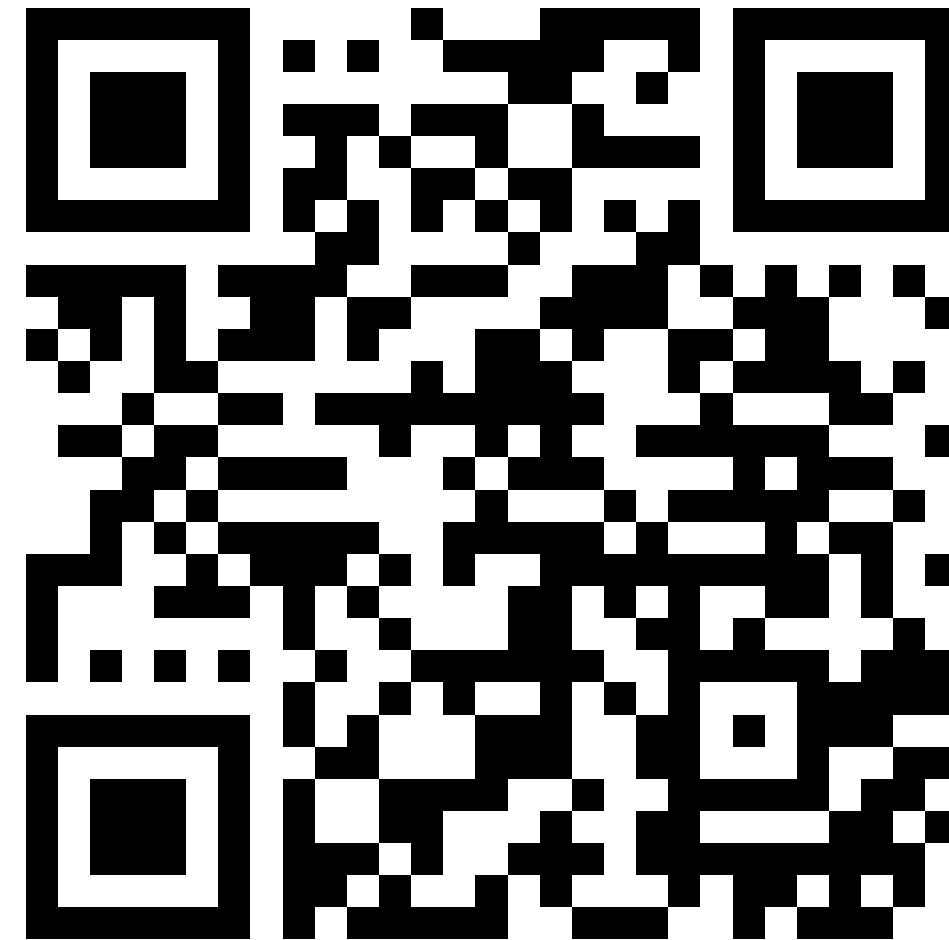
